You can freely criticize ORMTA – we value that, because we learn from it. But you should be respectful of the opinions and viewpoints of other visitors. Protect your privacy and that of others by not giving out contact information (such as name, address, phone number, or email address).

Messages will not be kept if they contain: promotions not related to music education, profanity, comments that aren't relevant to the topic, links to websites with inappropriate content, personal attacks directed at story subjects or another reader, or "spammed" material that has been posted in multiple places.
